New Event: Trek and Trail with the Llamas at Chiddingstone Castle

On 10 July 2011 Llamas will be coming to Chiddingstone Castle. This is the first time an event of this nature has been held at the Castle, and it will give visitors a unique opportunity to 'trek' with these amazing animals in the stunning grounds of the Castle.

The event is designed to offer children a unique opportunity to learn about these gentle animals while having fun leading them around the Castle grounds.

The escorted walks will last around 30 minutes and will include a nature trail along country paths and through woodland.

The event is suitable for children aged 3 and over. Children under 14 to be accompanied by a responsible adult. The cost of the trek will be £7 per person (the accompanying adult is free of charge). The Llamas will be at the Castle between 11 am and 4 pm.

The event will run alongside the vintage Bentley Picnic also taking place on 10 July at the Castle.

The Llamas are set to return to the Castle as a regular event during the school summer holidays when the trails will last around 45 minutes with an additional walk round the tranquil lake and past the walled gardens in the Castle grounds.
